

## Atlantic City Electric Giving Free Trees to Help Customers Save Energy

Atlantic City Electric is giving away 1,000 free trees to residential customers through the Arbor Day Foundation's Energy-Saving Trees program. This initiative helps customers conserve energy and reduce household energy use through strategic tree planting. For the eighth year, Atlantic City Electric is stepping up to support this important environmental and energy saving program. While supplies last, customers can reserve one free tree per household by visiting [arborday.org/ace](http://arborday.org/ace).

Customers will have the ability to choose from a selection of trees, including Bald Cypress, River Birch, and Sweet Gum. This year for the first time, customers can select a White Dogwood in a five-gallon container. Properly planted trees can provide a homeowner many benefits, such as reducing energy use through summer shading and by slowing winter winds. Since 2012, Atlantic City Electric customers have planted more than 12,300 trees, saving nearly 26 million kWh, and removing close to 200,000 lbs. of air pollutants from the atmosphere.

One-gallon trees will be delivered to customers' homes between April and May. The Five-gallon White Dogwood must be pre-ordered on line and will be **available for pick-up only** on Saturday, April 13 from 12pm to 2pm at Atlantic City Electric's Mays Landing Office, located at 5100 Harding Highway, Mays Landing, NJ 08330.
