The Mannington Township Committee Budget meeting was called to order by Mayor Asay at 3:30 PM. The following were in attendance: Asay, Patrick, Emel, Mitchell, Bowman, and Township Auditor, Fred Caltabiano of Bowman & Co. LLP.

Clerk certified that this meeting had been advertised in accordance with the Sunshine Law.

The meeting was turned over to the Township Auditor, Fred Caltabiano. Caltabiano distributed a memo regarding assessed valuations and fund balances. The local tax levy is approximately \$25,000 less than last year. At the present time, \$18,164.93 equals a penny (.01) in tax. The average assessed home is \$172,000.

Deferred school tax was explained. Mannington does not use this method.

The Auditor and the Committee reviewed and discussed the tentative 2020 Budget document. Minor changes were made. The tax rate remained level with no increase in the local tax.

Introduction of the 2020 Budget was scheduled for April 2, 2020.

Public Comment period was opened and closed by regular motion.

There being no other business, the Mayor adjourned the meeting by regular motion at 4:35 PM.
