

PRIMARY ELECTION, 2021

Frequently Asked Questions

When is the Primary Election?

Tuesday, June 8th, 2021

Will voters be allowed to vote in person?

YES, from 6:00 AM until 8:00 PM, unless you have already requested a Mail-in ballot.

Is there a deadline to change my party?

YES, the deadline to change your party affiliation is April 14th. You can do so by submitting a Voter Registration Form (Party Affiliation) to Board of Elections at: 110 Fifth Street, Suite 1000, Salem, NJ 08079. Feel free to call the Board of Elections or the County Clerk's Office at 856-935-7510 to make sure your party choice and mailing address information is correct.

When is the deadline to register to vote?

The deadline to register to vote is May 18th, 2021. If mailing your registration, it must be postmarked by May 18th, 2021. If delivering your registration to the Salem County Board of Elections at: 110 Fifth Street, Suite 1000, Salem, NJ 08079, it must be received by 9 PM, May 18th, 2021.

Will there be early voting at the polling locations?

Not for the Primary Election. We are hopeful to have early voting for the General Election, November 2021.

How will I know where to find my polling location?

Prior to the election, you will receive a "Sample Ballot" with notification of your polling location and District #. You can also find your polling location on the Board of Elections website:

What will the Ballots look like?

Ballots will be posted on the Salem County Clerk website: <https://salemcountyclerk.org/election-services/#sample>

If a voter goes to his/her polling location on Election Day and is told that their status is a "Vote By Mail" voter -

The voter CAN vote Provisionally at the polling location. Provisional Ballots will be counted once it is verified that the voter has not already submitted a Mail-in ballot.

Can an Unaffiliated/Independent Voter vote in a Primary Election? Yes

If voting at your Polling Location: An Unaffiliated/Independent voter must request either a Republican or Democratic ballot. Please understand that once you request a ballot, you are then considered a voter affiliated to that particular party until you request, in writing, to change your party affiliation through a Voter Registration Form - Party Affiliation - found on the Board of Elections website:

elections@salemcountynj.gov

If Vote by Mail: An Unaffiliated/Independent voter WILL receive two ballots in the mail; 1 Republican ballot and 1 Democratic ballot. A voter can only return 1 ballot. We ask that you destroy the non-voted ballot. Once the voter returns the ballot of their choice, the voter is then considered affiliated to that particular party until a request in writing - Voter Registration Form – Party Affiliation - found on the Board of Elections website: elections@salemcountynj.gov

IF a voter returns both a Republican AND a Democratic ballot, that have been voted, both ballots will be REJECTED.

IF the voter chooses not to vote at all, they should destroy the ballots and accompanying envelopes.

What can we expect to be different when voting in person for the Primary Election?

- Social distancing will be required
- Face coverings will be required
- Contact points will be thoroughly cleaned
- Poll location will be thoroughly disinfected
- Hand sanitizers will be provided for the voters
- Pens and stylus will be provided and given to the voter to keep
- New voting machines have been certified and will be deployed to all polling locations

Vote By Mail (VBM)

Am I an In-Person Voter or a Vote By Mail Voter? Not sure?

If you would like to confirm your voting status (Vote by Mail **or** in-person voter), please call the County Clerk's Office at: 856-935-7510 x8454.

Who is going to receive a VBM Ballot?

Only voters that have requested a Mail-in ballot via an application previously submitted to the Salem County Clerk's Office.

If you are a Vote by Mail voter (VBM) but wish to return to your polling location on Election Day:

Complete and submit an "Opt Out" Form found on the Salem County Clerk's website or call the Clerk's Office, at: 856-935-7510 x8454 to have an "Opt Out" Form mailed to you. (Form link on last page)

If you have received a Mail-in ballot and wish to vote at your polling location, **YOU MUST RETURN** your non-voted ballot to the Salem County Clerk's Office, located at: 110 Fifth Street, Suite 200, Salem, NJ 08079, (Weekdays, 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM) at least 7 days before the Election.

When will ballots be mailed to voters who have requested Mail-in ballots?

You can expect to receive your ballot the first week of May 2021.

Is there a deadline to request a ballot be mailed?

YES, Tuesday, June 1st, 2021, seven (7) days before the Election.

If you requested a Mail-in ballot and did not receive it:

We ask our voters to **BE PATIENT AND WAIT** until the second week of May to allow the US Postal Service time to deliver. If you did not receive your ballot in the mail, please call the Clerk's Office at: 856-935-7510 x8454 or visit the Clerk's Office, located at: 110 Fifth Street, Suite 200, Salem, NJ 08079. Office hours are 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM every weekday, except holidays.

What should I do if I lose my ballot, or it is damaged?

If your VBM Ballot is lost or damaged, call the County Clerk's Office at: 856-935-7510 x8454 for instruction.

Is there a deadline to pick up a ballot and vote it at the County Clerk's Office?

YES, Monday, June 7th, 2021, by 3 PM.

What is a Bearer?

A Bearer is a person who is delivering a voted Mail-in Ballot for someone other than themselves.

What does a Bearer do?

A Bearer delivers a voted Mail-in Ballot directly to the Board of Elections, on behalf of another voter. The Bearer **MUST SIGN** the Bearer Portion of the Outer Envelope, in the presence of the voter when taking custody of the ballot. The Bearer **MUST SIGN** the Bearer Book at the Board of Elections.

Bearer Limits?

There is a **THREE** ballot limit per Bearer, in addition to their own ballot; **FIVE** ballots if immediate family member living in the same household.

Do I have to provide postage to return the mailed ballot?

NO, all ballots will have prepaid return postage provided for your convenience.

May I return my VBM Ballot to the polling location on Primary Election Day?

No. Your options to return your Mail-in ballot are:

- 1) Return by mail (postage prepaid) – must be postmarked by Election Day.
- 2) Place your ballot (with appropriate envelopes) into one of the Drop Boxes throughout Salem County - The Salem County Offices, at 110 Fifth Street, Salem, NJ 08079 has a Drop Box. Ballots are picked up daily and delivered to Board of Elections. The last pickup will be 8:00 PM on Election Day.
- 3) Return your ballot (with appropriate envelopes) directly to the Board of Elections between the hours of 8:30 AM and 4:30 PM each weekday. Ballots will also be received until 8:00PM on Election Day. Board of Elections Address: 110 Fifth Street, Suite 1000, Salem, NJ 08079.

How will I know where to find the secure drop box locations?

Contact the Board of Elections at 856-935-7510. The County Clerk's office will post the locations on its website once the locations have been identified. (Links provided on last page)

Do all Mail-In (VBM) Ballots get counted?

Ballots that are properly cast are canvassed and counted.

The #1 REASON BALLOTS ARE REJECTED IS BECAUSE THE CERTIFICATION ENVELOPE IS NOT SIGNED!

- 1) Print your name and address

Options to return:

- 1) United States Postal Service (postage paid)
- 2) Drop box – check elections@salemcountynj.gov for box locations (picked up daily)
- 3) Directly to the Board of Elections

Will I be notified if my Mail-in Ballot is Rejected?

YES, the Board of Elections will mail you a letter, or call if you provided your contact information on the Certification envelope and give you a specified time limit to correct the problem - **watch your mail and listen to your voice messages!** The letter and/or call will instruct you on how to fix the problem and will provide an email address, fax number and address of: 110 Fifth Street, Suite 1000, Salem, NJ 08079, to return your correction letter.
