**MANNINGTON TOWNSHIP BOARD OF HEALTH**

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT  
WITH THE COUNTY OF SALEM**

**WHEREAS**, the County of Salem possesses the personnel and equipment necessary to provide public health services of a technical and professional nature; and

**WHEREAS**, Mannington Township is in need of public health services in order to satisfy its obligations under *N.J.S.A. 26:1A-1, et. seq.*; and

**WHEREAS**, *N.J.S.A. 40A:65-4, et seq.*, authorizes a municipality and a county to enter into contracts for the joint provision of any service which any party to the agreement is empowered to render within its jurisdiction; and

**WHEREAS**, the Salem County Board of Chosen Freeholders and Mannington Township Board of Health have determined that it would be mutually beneficial to enter into a Shared Services Agreement whereby Mannington could utilize the public health services offered by the County of Salem; and

**WHEREAS**, this contract shall be considered a Shared Services Agreement pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1, et. seq.*, and shall have a term of five years beginning September 1, 2024 and ending August 31, 2029; and

**WHEREAS**, a copy of the Shared Services Agreement has been attached hereto as Exhibit A.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED**, by the Mannington Township Board of Health that on May 2, 2024, the Mannington Township Board of Health duly authorized the Mayor to execute the Shared Services Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A with the County of Salem on behalf of Mannington Township Board of Health, and that the Mayor and Township Committee hereby ratifies the execution of that Agreement;

**AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Clerk certify a copy of this Resolution and file it on the public record.

**PUBLIC COMMENT :**
