LAC Recycling Center is located at 8 Pecks Corner Road, Harmersville,
and accepts recyclables only - NO TRASH - NO TIRES

SPECIALTY ITEMS

CHRISTMAS TREES: The trash truck **will not** pick-up Christmas trees. Call Mannington Townhall to schedule pick-up (856-935-2359 ext. 150) or residents may take them to the Salem County Improvement Authority (856-935-7900).

GRASS CLIPPINGS & LEAVES: No leaves or grass clippings will be picked up. Homeowners may mulch on their own property, or make their own arrangements for disposal. (Do not put in trash)

EMPTY PAINT CANS: Water based or Lucite paints - Leave can open to dry and then place in regular trash.

OIL BASED PAINTS: Must be disposed of at a County "Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day".

BUILDING MATERIAL FROM REMODELING: Disposal of remodeling or construction debris is the responsibility of property owner. Call the Salem County Improvement Authority @ 856-935-7900 for disposal details. **DO NOT PLACE IN TRASH CAN(S).**

WASTE OIL & CAR BATTERIES: Residents may take to the Public Works Department for disposal. **CONTAINERS & BATTERIES MUST BE PUT ON THE DESIGNATED CEMENT PAD.** *NOTE:* All alkaline batteries (rechargeable, A, B, C, D and 9-volt) are not considered hazardous waste and should be put in your household trash.

BULK TRASH PICK-UP: Items will be picked up the 2nd & the 4th Friday of the month, unless there is a scheduled holiday. Items too large to place in your trash can are considered "*bulk trash*". Call 856-935-2359 ext. 150 to schedule a pick-up. **48-hours' notice is required.** Bulk items should be placed at curbside by 6:30 a.m. Residents may dispose of 6 bulk items per year at no charge. Each item over the six-item limit will be charged fifteen dollars (\$15.00), payable in advance.

- Bulk Trash: Bulk items include: sofas, box spring & mattresses, doors, desktops or personal computers, computer monitor, portable computers, or televisions, refrigerators, stoves, or items too large to fit in your trash can.
- Carpet & Wood: **MUST BE BUNDLED AND TIED.**
 - No more than 50 lbs.
 - No more than 5ft. long
 - Can be cut into squares or strips, tied or duct taped

LIMB PICK-UP:

Mannington Township will pick up tree limbs from residential properties within Mannington Township on the **3rd Monday of each month.** Requests for tree limb pick-up must be received by Mannington Township no less than forty-eight (48) hours prior to the next scheduled pick-up date. Tree limb pick-up may be requested by calling (856) 935-2359, ext. 150.

Requests for tree limb pick-up are limited to five (5) requests per calendar year per residential address. Tree limbs must be stacked or placed in one (1) single pile or row along the residential property's public road frontage. **No more than one (1) pile or row of tree limbs will be removed by the Township per scheduled pick-up.** The cut ends of all tree limbs must face the public road. No tree limb may have a cut end that is larger than six (6) inches in diameter. The pile or row of tree limbs may be no more than four (4) feet high, and no more than twenty (20) feet in length along the public road. If tree limbs are stacked or placed in *multiple* piles or rows, or if a pile or row of tree limbs is *improperly* stacked, located, or aligned, or if a pile or row of tree limbs contains one or more tree limbs that *exceed six (6) inches* in diameter, the Township's personnel may elect not to pick up any of the tree limbs.

If a pile or row of tree limbs exceeds the aforesaid maximum 4' H x 20' L dimensions but is otherwise properly stacked and placed, the Township's personnel may elect to pick up some but not all of the tree limbs. **PILES/ROWS OF TREE LIMBS MUST CONTAIN NO STUMPS, VINES, THORNS, OR OTHER DEBRIS.** If a pile or row of tree limbs contains stumps, vines, thorns, or other debris, the Township's personnel may elect not to pick up any of the tree limbs or other materials in the pile.

A request for tree limb pick-up, and the placement of stacks or rows of tree limbs at a residential property for pick-up, will constitute permission and authorization for the Township's personnel

to access the property to pick up the tree limbs, and to operate chippers and other machinery at and near the property in connection with the tree limb removal and disposal activities. The Township's personnel are not required to rake, sweep, or otherwise remove any leaves, branches, stems, wood chips, sawdust, or other debris from the property or the public roadway, whether or not such materials result from the tree limb pick-up or disposal operations.

Mannington Township's tree limb pick-up service is provided only to assist residents with removal of tree limbs that have fallen due to storms or other natural occurrences, or that have been trimmed or pruned as part of an owner's normal residential property maintenance. The Township does not remove downed trees. The Township does not pick up tree limbs from commercial, institutional, or industrial properties, or from farms or wooded properties without single-family residences. No tree limbs from out-of-Township properties may be placed for pick-up on properties within Mannington Township.

TIRES: Call 856-935-2359 ext.150 to schedule for pick-up. Charges are payable in advance & as follows:

All other tires larger than stated above are not picked up by the township - Call the Salem County Utilities Authority @ 856-935-7900 for disposal details.

PROJECT MEDICINE DROP: The New Jersey Division of Consumer Affairs has developed **Project Medicine Drop** as an important component of its effort to halt the abuse and diversion of prescription drugs. It allows consumers to dispose of unused and expired medications anonymously, seven days a week, 365 days a year, at prescription drug drop boxes located within the headquarters of participating police departments.
