The Mannington Township Committee Budget Work-Session was called to order by Mayor Asay at 3:00 PM. The following were in attendance: Asay, Patrick, Emel, Mitchell, Bowman, and Township Auditor, Fred Caltabiano of Bowman & Co. LLP.

Clerk certified that this meeting had been advertised in accordance with the Sunshine Law.

NEW BUSINESS:

Motion was made by Patrick, seconded by Emel, approving of two appraisal quotes for the Earl Moore Farm relating to the FIG. Roll call vote as follows: Asay - yes Patrick - yes Emel - yes

The quotes submitted were from Sheehan & Associates, LLC in the amount of \$2,100.00 and Justin Molinari of Molinari Associates in the amount of \$2,200.00.

The meeting was turned over to the Township Auditor, Fred Caltabiano. Caltabiano and the Committee reviewed and discussed the tentative 2019 Budget document. Minor changes were made to keep the tax rate level. Introduction of the 2019 Budget was scheduled for April 4, 2019. There was no increase in the local tax.

OTHER BUSINESS:

Mayor Asay brought up the list of Township-owned properties talked about at the last meeting. He is going to ask Carl Gaskill, Township Engineer, if some of the very small, odd pieces of land can be added to the township right-of-ways.

Public Comment period was opened and closed by regular motion.
